Contest Guidelines

Your cover design can be as imaginative as you like, but the following guidelines should be kept in mind:

1. **Lion** – Since the lion is the symbol of the magazine as well as the school itself, a lion should be part of the drawing.
2. **Signature** – Be sure to sign your design somewhere.
3. **Size** – All designs should be 8.5" x 5.5", either on a piece of paper that size or fit into a space that size on a standard piece of paper.
4. **Color** – The cover will be printed in color again this year, so please take advantage of that in your designs! All drawing and printing must be dark and clear in order for your designs to come out properly in the printing process.
